

DOCUMENTS TO HAVE ON BOARD:

- Updated insurance policy and receipt
- Boat registration documents
- Declaration of Conformity
- Marpol Document
- Rescue equipment in order



Before leaving the port:

- 1. Check the weather conditions (download WINDY APP)
- 2. Remove the covers
- 3. Connect the battery(ies)
- 4. Connect the smoke extractor (BLOWER) /except diesel engines which connect automatically and wait 4 minutes before starting the engine
- 5. Check where is the safety equipment
- 6. Check "man overboard"
- 7. Operate the starter and disconnect the BLOWER 4 minutes after starting the engine
- 8. Check the fuel level
- 9. Remember to disconnect the smoke extractor
- 10. Release the guide rope and check that it is not snagged on the anchor, fenders, etc.
- 11. Remove the fenders
- 12. Quickly operate the pump and turn it off a few minutes later

After entering the port:

- 1. Attach the habour mooring lines to the cleats
- 2. Stop the engine
- 3. Attach the guide rope
- 4. Disconnect the battery(ies)
- 5. Wash the boat with fresh water
- 6. Put on the covers



Go to channel 9 at low power. Press the transmit button, and remember to speak slowly and clearly, and end each communication with OVER.

You say

Wait for a response (2 minutes)

Make your request

We are "Name of the boat", can we come in for OVER.

Wait for the response, and you will be notified if entry is possible If it is possible, you will be told where to put the boat.

VHF WITH DSC

You are in distress if:

There is a SERIOUS AND IMMINENT DANGER involving a person, Vessel, Aircraft or Vehicle AND IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE IS REQUIRED

What you need to do:

- ·Press the red button once
- ·Press the red button and hold it down for 5 seconds
- ·Wait 15 seconds
- •The radio will automatically switch back to channel 16

Speak CALMLY and CLEARLY into the microphone saying:

Mayday, Mayday, Mayday

This is "XXX XXX XXX" (repeat the name of the boat 3 times)

MMSI "235 112 831" (example)

[pause]

Mayday

«XXX» (the name of the boat once)

MMSI «235 112 831» (example)

My position is (latitude & longitude or actual distance from a mapped location)

l am (nature of distress)

I require immediate assistance

.... people on board

Other VITAL information

OVER

Release the transmit button and wait for a response
